"An influential presence in Southeast Asia, and particularly in Thailand, her home country, Ms. Sanpitak embeds cultural specifics in abstract forms. In her second New York solo, she takes as her theme the image of floral garlands made for Thai ceremonial occasions, from weddings to funerals, transforming them into origami-like cloth wall hangings and minimalist paintings accented with dried blossoms. Garlands of real flowers, fresh when the show opened, link cast metal versions of the breastlike forms that the artist has used repeatedly over her three-decade career." - Holland Cotter

"SOPHEAP PICH" THE NEW YORKER, DECEMBER 2015 "Born in 1971, in Cambodia, Pich fled the Khmer Rouge for America, where

he studied at the Art Institute of Chicago before returning home, in 2002. Here, wall-mounted rattan dowels form lattices that evoke incarceration; an oversized model of a flowering plant is installed upside down, its petals and stems made of the same fragile caning. Pich's works are freighted with the atrocities of Cambodian history, but they're also daringly quiet. The best of them recall the work of another diffident master, the American sculptor Martin Puryear."
