

FALL NEWSLETTER

We had an exciting start to our fall season with the opening of *Shocking Pink Story*, Manit Sriwanichpoom's first solo exhibition in the United States, which closes on October 27. Our exhibition program continues with Sopheap Pich's *Expanses*, opening on November 1. This solo exhibition will coincide with showings of his work at the National Gallery Singapore and the Albright-Knox Art Gallery. It will include his large-scale sculpture, *Ordeal*, which comes to us directly from an exhibition at the Asian Civilisations Museum in Singapore, as well as new drawings that continue the series he developed for last year's Venice Biennale. The public is cordially invited to join the artist for the opening reception on November 1, from 6:00 – 8:00 pm. We will round out the season on December 5 – 9 with a solo presentation of new works by Tiffany Chung at Art Basel Miami Beach, as we anticipate her solo exhibition at the Smithsonian American Art Museum opening next March.

Our artists will participate in a wide range of museum exhibitions and biennials this season. Museum MACAN in Jakarta will present a major survey of Arahmaiani's multi-faceted career, featuring over 70 works from the 1980s until today, including paintings, installations, and re-enactments of iconic performances. Currently in the US, newly acquired installations by Agus Suwage are showcased in exhibitions at the Albright-Knox Art Gallery and the Toledo Museum of Art. And an array of Tiffany Chung's installations and cartographic works from 2010-2017 are on view at Asia Society in Houston. Please see below for further information about these and other highlights. 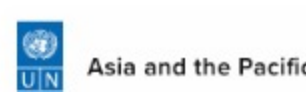
